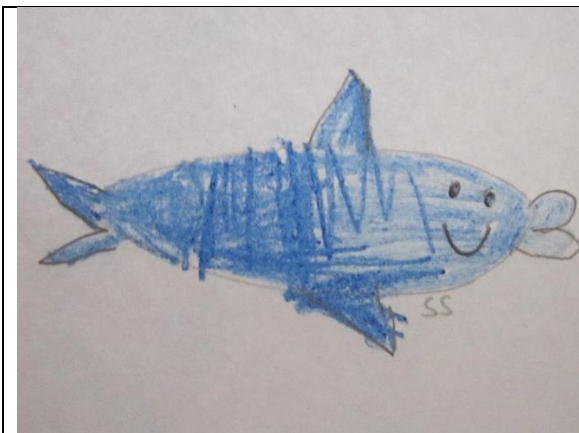


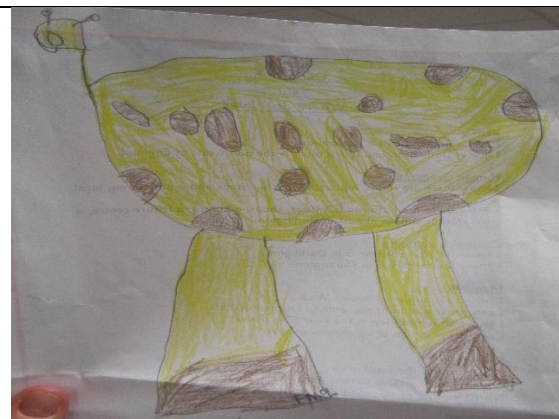
What do animals eat?
