



## Year 1 and Year 2 take up the reading challenge!

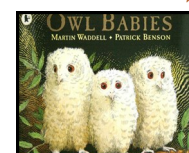
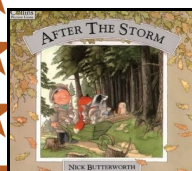
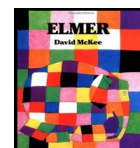
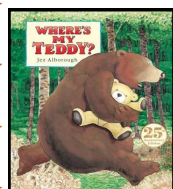
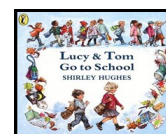
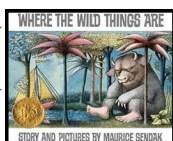
